**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(CAP. 427)**

**Airborne Noise Emitted by Household Appliances (Repeal)
Regulations, 2007**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 38 to 40 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Competitiveness and Communications, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, has made the following regulations:–

1. (1) The title of these regulations is Airborne Noise Emitted by Household Appliances (Repeal) Regulations, 2007. Citation, scope and commencement.

(2) These regulations implement the requirements of article 22 of Directive 2005/32/EC¹ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 6th July 2005 Establishing a Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for Energy-Using Products and Amending Council Directive 92/42/EEC² and Directives 96/57/EC³ and 2000/55/EC⁴ of the European Parliament and of the Council, hereinafter referred to as “the Directive”.

(3) These regulations shall come into force on the 11th August, 2007.

2. The Airborne Noise Emitted by Household Appliances Regulations, 2002 are hereby being repealed. Repeals L.N. 91 of 2002.
