Registration of water tankers

The Malta Resources Authority would like to draw the attention of the owners of water tankers (browsers) that according to Legal Notice 167 of 1997, as amended by Legal Notice 426 of 2007, every vehicle used for the transportation of water must be registered.

The law refers to all water tankers used for the transportation of water, including wastewater, sea water, storm water run-off, trade effluent, ground water and wholesome water.

Registrations shall be submitted by the owner or legal representative on Regulation 3 and should include all the particulars and specifications of the water tanker including the model of the vehicle, engine and chassis number, the capacity and classification of water transported. Owners of trailer-tankers shall submit technical details relevant to the trailer as required by the ADT for issue of the road licence.

The registration of water tankers involves an administration cost of €69.88, paid to the Malta Resources Authority. If a water tanker is registered by more than one person, only one administration charge will be paid.

The Malta Resources Authority warns that legal action will be taken against those who fail to register their water tanker or trailer and those who submit false information.
